Key Facts

- Queen Victoria ruled Britain for 64 years. She loved singing and going to the opera. She enjoyed painting and drawing. She also loved dogs-her favourite was a dog called Dash!
- Queen Elizabeth II is Britain's longest reigning monarch. She loves horse riding, pigeon racing, and football - she's an Arsenal supporter! She loves corgi dogs too.

- ancestor- a person who was in someone's family in past times.
- coronation- when a king or queen is crowned.

- family tree-a chart or diagram representing generations of families and how they are linked throughout the years. Includes names, birth dates, marriage dates and pictures.
- marriage- is a union between two individual people.
- monarch- a king or queen, an emperor or a sultan.
- relative- a person connected with another by ancestry or marriage.
- sibling-a brother or sister
- similarities- things that are the same.
- succession- this is the order in which a monarch's family will take over the throne.

Timeline of events-Queen Victoria 24th May 1819 -Victoria was born, her father was Edward, Duke of Kent, and her mother was Princess Maria Louisa Victoria of Saxe-Coburg-Saalfald.

28th June 1838-became Queen when her uncle William IV died. Her coronation was at Westminster Abbeu

10th February 1840 -married to Prince Albert

10th March 1964 - Prince Edward was born.

9th April 2021-Prince Philip died.
