Autumn 2016

Topics Covered

Over Autumn Term

English

This term we will be looking at a variety of genres including narrative and instruction writing. The children will continue to do comprehension work on a weekly basis, answering questions about texts that they have read. Children will complete a writing piece each week giving them chance to show what they have learnt. We will also be focusing on handwriting.

Maths

This term we will be focusing on place value and number work. We will also be doing addition and subtraction. The children will be re-capping on the times tables facts they have learnt so far and then moving on further. The topic for problem solving this term is finding all possibilities.

Science

This term we will be learning about Earth and Light. We will be learning about pollution, the solar system, sources of light and shadows.

Art

We will be researching and creating Stone Age inspired art work.

Computing

In ICT we will be researching our History topics. We will be learning key skills for Microsoft word. We will also be using design software as part of our DT project.
